MONEY OR STUFF?

MONEY HELPS KEEP THE SHELTER DOORS OPEN

- helps to provide program services free of charge
- services include: shelter, outreach, children's group programs, family court support, transitional housing, helpline, walk-in support and more



WOMEN'S SHELTERS WOULD NOT BE ABLE TO OPERATE WITHOUT THE **ITEM DONATIONS** THE COMMUNITY PROVIDES

- check with your local shelter for needed items lists, which often include: laundry soap, paper products, coffee, cereal, unused personal needs items and daily household supplies
- women and children often arrive with few personal items
- care packs can go a long way to make someone feel welcome, these include: new pyjamas and slippers, underwear, socks, personal need items like shampoo and toothbrushes, and a teddy bear and game for each child

GENTLY USED ITEMS CAN BE TRICKIER



- ask yourself whether or not you would wear the items you are donating
- many shelters are not able to accept used baby equipment or furniture due to health and safety reasons
- gently used linens, blankets and towels, and new pillows are always appreciated

THE ANSWER IS: BOTH. BOTH MONETARY DONATIONS AS WELL AS ITEM DONATIONS ARE HIGHLY NEEDED AND MUCH APPRECIATED BY SHELTERS.
